Tap water - Are you satisfied with the purity and freshness of your drinking water?

Chlorination of municipal water supply leads to chemical by-products remaining in your drinking water, and long-term exposure to these chemicals may increase health risks. Addition to chlorine and its disinfectant by-products, your municipal water may contain hundreds of man-made chemicals found in fertilizers and pesticides.

Are you frustrated by your water's lack of consistency in taste and odor? A natural occurrence in all surface water supplies, an "algal bloom", is responsible for the taste and odor changes in the treated drinking water supply. Algal blooms can occur at any time if the right conditions exist in the water supply.

Chlorine and other harsh chemicals can harm the plumbing fixtures, faucets and pipes in your home as well.

Bottled water is less regulated than tap water.

Many consumers of bottled water assume that it is cleaner than tap water. Bottled water is regulated by the FDA, and while standards for lead content are more stringent than Federal public water standards, other quality standards are same as Federal limits for public supplies. Bottlers, however are not required to disclose either the content or the source of their water, as is the case for public supplies. Up to 40% of bottled water is simply drawn from municipal supplies and receives no additional filtration or other treatment.

This makes drinking bottled water expensive and wasteful. Up to 1.5 million tons of plastic is produced annually and disposed of in our landfills.

How does carbon work?

Carbon water filters are the most commonly utilized filtration system by homeowners. A carbon water filter is used to adsorb impurities found in water including rust, sediment and dirt as well as the very important and potentially harmful gases like chlorine, chloramine and the subsequent disinfectant byproducts. By removing these contaminants, carbon rids your water of unpleasant odors and even bad taste.

Carbon is a substance which has a long been used to absorb impurities and is perhaps the most powerful absorbent known to man. One pound of activated carbon contains the surface area of 125 acres and can absorb literally thousands of different chemicals. Activated carbon is carbon which has a slight electro-positive charge added to it, making it even more attractive to chemicals and impurities. As the water passes over the positively charged carbon surface, the negative ions of the contaminants are drawn to the surface of the carbon granules.

Activated carbon filters reduce many volatile organic compounds (VOCs), pesticides and herbicides, as well as chlorine, benzene and hundreds of other man-made chemicals found in tap water.
